The Fund's total return for the quarter to 30th September was +2.1%.

Fund value at 30th September was £23.2 billion.

<u>Pension Administration Strategy -</u> Consultation

Our Pension Administration Strategy sets out how we work in partnership with our employers to provide the LGPS for their employees.

HMRC are introducing a change to the treatment of Termination / exit payments from April 2020.

Our understanding is that where exit Payments exceed 30k, the excess will be subject to Employer national insurance payments.
