169 sets out the rates and bands applicable from April 2018 for various purposes, including **automatic enrolment**:

- April 2018 increases to employee
 contribution bands / CARE
 accounts / pensions in payment will
 be based on 3%
- The **lifetime allowance** will be £1,030,000 in 2018 / 2019
- The max **APC** rises to £6,565
