Late retirement increases

SPPA / GAD have published revised actuarial factors for late retirements (after NPA).

They will be effective for retiral dates from 24 April 2017.

The new factors will result in smaller increases than the current factors.

We plan to contact all Cllr and employee members aged 65+ to make them aware of the change.

Member contribution rates for 17/18

We expect the SPPA to increase the tiered pensionable pay bands for employee contributions for 2017 / 2018 by 1%.

We will issue the 2017 / 2018 employee contribution tables as soon as we have them.

We will shortly issue our requirements of you by email.

They will also be available from the Employers > More info area of our website, be similar to last year (NI contracted out earnings will of course not be needed this year) and have a 12 May deadline.
