This month we will be **mailing new** starts who joined between 1 April 2014 and 31 March 2015 about LGPS 2015, as these members will not have been made aware of the LGPS 2015 info in Fundnews 2014.

This month we will be mailing all of our active members who are either also a deferred or also a pensioner member to make them aware that the LGPS will only provide one death grant – the highest – in respect of their various LGPS memberships if they die in service.
